

## Board Member Conflict of Interest

State law allows persons related to school district employees to serve on Boards of Education provided that such persons were serving on September 1, 1992. However, no such members, if related within the second degree of consanguinity or affinity to a teacher or other employee of the district, shall attend or participate in any regular or executive session of the board held to consider any personnel matter or litigation relating to said teacher or employee.

The same law does allow such members to vote on collective bargaining agreements or the renewal of contracts as a group if the vote is necessary to form a quorum of the board.

It is the policy of the Alva Board of Education that, if it should occur that there is more than one member of the board in such a circumstance, the member whose office is designated by the lower number shall be the member who is allowed to vote.
