

Board Member Development Opportunities

Board Member Continuing Education

To insure that board members are kept aware of their progress in satisfying the continuing education requirements as specified by state law the board:

1. Designates the superintendent as the person to notify the State Department of Education of any changes in board personnel;
2. Designates the superintendent as the person responsible for informing all board members of their continuing education requirements at the time of their election, or appointment and quarterly thereafter;
3. Designates the superintendent as the person to receive quarterly reports from the State Department of Education related to hours of continuing education credit earned by board members;
4. Requires that the superintendent report to the board, at its next regular meeting following the receipt of such reports, the information contained in the quarterly reports of the State Department of Education related to continuing education.
